Historic City

MARKET SQUARE
was renovated thoroughly from 1998 to 1999. The drinking fountains are reminiscent of four medieval wells.
The ‚Fischerbrunnen‘ (Fisherman Fountain) situated at the nearby fish market was made by the sculptor Jo Jastram and finished in 2000.

7 RAMPARTS
After its destruction in 1782, the fortification was redesigned as a promenade, remaining a prime example of 18th and 19th century horticulture.

10 THE RUBENOW MONUMENT
was created by the architect August Stüler in 1856 and inaugurated at the 4th centenary of the city's university. It was renovated in 2005. The Rubenow Square was redesigned in celebration of the university's 550th anniversary in 2006.

12 MAIN BUILDING OF THE UNIVERSITY
was built together with its baroque assembly hall by the Greifswald mathematics professor Andreas Mayer in 1747-1750.

13 ST. SPIRITUS - SOCIAL AND - CULTURAL CENTRE 
was mentioned in writing as early as 1262 and was once a medieval hospital. Its courtyard construction dates to the 18th century. Nowadays it serves as a place for diverse art and culture activities.

18 THE OLD UNIVERSITY LIBRARY
was built by Martin Gropius in 1882 and is situated in Rubenow Street 4. It is open for visitors on weekdays.

21 29 MUSEUM HARBOUR AND DUNGEON TOWER

The old city harbour of Greifswald is dedicated to traditional ships and boats from 1994 on. The dungeon tower, whose first written mention was in 1329, was an observatory from 1775 to 1826. Nowadays it functions as the office of the Museum Harbour.

23 MONUMENT OF CASPAR DAVID FRIEDRICH

A life-sized monument of the painter Caspar David Friedrich was placed here in his home town. It was unveiled on the 8th of May 2010. It is the first statue of the painter worldwide, cast in bronze by the Lübeck sculptor Claus Görtz, on behalf of the Maletzke Foundation.

26 TOWN HALL 
was first mentioned as ‚Kophus‘ in 1369. It is the seat of the Mayor and the municipal government. The old council room, which is a wedding chamber nowadays, boasts a wall decoration from the 18th century. The entrance, a bronze door made by Jo Jastram in 1965, marks the city's peaceful surrender to the Red Army on 29 April, 1945.

31 MUSEUM SHIPYARD
At the ‚Buchholz'schen Werft‘ (Buchholz Shipyard) the old tradition of shipbuilding is still being practiced.

32 GOTHIC GABLE HOUSES
The foundation walls of the ‚Markt 11 House‘ originated in the beginning of the 15th century. The neighbouring ‚Markt 13 House‘ stands on 13th century foundation walls, with medieval beam constructions in the cellar.

36 MONASTERY LIBRARY
is part of the Pomeranian State Museum at present. It was built in the late 15th century. The building's design and a book donation from 1484 point to its use as a library and an auditorium.

6 ST. JACOBI (ST. JAMES'S CHURCH) 
This smallest medieval city parish church of Greifswald was firstly mentioned in 1275. Around 1400 the its was reconstructed into a three-nave church with a choir. Then, after a 1955 fire, the church received its current tower spire in 1966.

20 THE DOM ST. NIKOLAI (ST. NICHOLAS'S CATHEDRAL) 
was built in a neo-Gothic style. In 1456, the year Greifswald's university was founded, its consecration took place in the Cathedral. St. Nicholas Cathedral was also the baptism site of Caspar David Friedrich.

43 POST WINDMILL ELDENA

44 BUGENHAGEN'S CHURCH
The three-bay church is being gradually renovated since 1995. To the special exhibits belong the three-part Reredos which shows maritime biblical scenes and two votive ships. 45 WIECK WOODEN DRAWBRIDGE
The important monument was built in 1887 using the Dutch design for wooden draw bridges and is still operated by hand today. The Wieck wooden drawbridge connects Eldena with the heritage-protected village of Wieck. You can find current opening times at www.greifswald.de.

49 RUINS OF THE ELDENA MONASTERY
The former Cistercian monastery Hilda (later Eldena) was founded by Danish monks in 1199 at the mouth of the small river Ryck. It was destroyed during the 30 Years' War. Caspar David Friedrich, a prominent painter from the Romantic period, chose the ruin as the main motif for his work and thus made it famous around the world.
