

11.00 a.m.

Discover Greifswald's **historic Old Town** with its redbrick churches and front-gabled houses on a guided tour of the Old Town. You can buy your tickets at Greifswald-Information on the market square.

Duration: 1.5 hours

12.30 p.m.

Go aboard the **MS Stubnitz / MS Breege** and sail down the Ryck from the Museum Harbour to the idyllic fishing village of Wieck and beyond. You can buy your tickets on board or online at **vsg-reederei.de**

Duration: 0.5 – 2 hours

1.00 p.m.

Watch the drawing of the **historic wooden bascule bridge**, which is still done by hand, and count the sailboats passing by. Enjoy your lunch at one of **Wieck's fish restaurants** and try the fresh cod, herring or needlefish.

2.00 p.m.

Stroll along the **harbour-front promenade** to the modern **flood barrier** and take in the fantastic view of the Bay of Greifswald from the mole. Afterwards, stop off at the **Abbey Ruins in Eldena**. The former Cistercian abbey was made famous by Caspar David Friedrich's painting.

3.30 p.m.

Rent a bicycle from UsedomRad / StadtRad Greifswald* in Wieck and cycle along the old towpath back to the Old Town (5 km). The riverside path takes you past historic boats and modern yachts. Alternatively, take a bus (line 2) or the MS Stubnitz / MS Breege back to the Old Town. () Duration: 0.5 hours

4.00 p.m.

Get to know the town's most famous son and pay a visit to the **Caspar David Friedrich Centre** (open until 5.00 p.m.) and then to the **Pomeranian State Museum**. With the combined ticket, you get reduced admission to both museums. Or take your kids to **Tierpark Greifswald**, a charming little zoo with a natural feel.





6.00 p.m.

Enjoy your supper at a **restaurant or bar** in the Old Town or in the **historic Museum Harbour**. Some of the historic ships have been converted into restaurants for the perfect place to dine.

7.30 p.m.

Theater Vorpommern stages its own theatre, ballet and musical-theatre productions, as well as symphony concerts with the Philharmonic Orchestra Vorpommern all year round. » kulturkalender.greifswald.de

The zoo school and the natural history house with the zoo café enable adventures independently of every kind of weather, especially to celebrations of our zoological garden. At the end of your trip you can enjoy a small snack in a pleasant atmosphere.



Our zoological garden is worth a visit in all the seasons. Lovely created and nature-orientated enclosures for the animals enable interesting insights in the fascinating wildlife of those animals. If meerkats, cotton-top tamarins, coatis, raccoons, porcupines, dingos or nutrias - everywhere something can be observed. Especially intense is the direct contact with our animals in the walk-in enclosures of the capuchins, white storks, mini goats and kangaroos. You can experience very close contact with the impressive capybaras while they get fed or observe the diversity of our bird species. In addition to our bees house, the chicken house is a special adventure, because chickens can be observed while enclosing. But you also can just relax in our park with a nice view on the swan pond. On your tour through our park you can experience "game elements for opening your senses" like the water swirl or the bird voices simulator or the water playground. In the whole park you can find nice places for sitting and relaxing.
